1 WHEREAS, Colonel Frank Plummer of McAllen served his country
2 faithfully and bravely during his 32 years in the U.S. Army, and he
3 is truly deserving of special recognition; and

4 WHEREAS, A native of Coalgate, Oklahoma, Colonel Plummer
5 joined the U.S. Army as a private in 1943 and fought in the Pacific
6 theater during World War II as a first lieutenant; and

7 WHEREAS, This distinguished soldier remained in the army for
8 three decades after the war, serving in Germany, Korea, Vietnam,
9 Norway, Italy, Japan, and the United States; over the course of his
10 military career, he earned the Purple Heart, the Bronze Star with
11 "V" device, the Silver Star, three Legion of Merit medals, seven
12 Crosses of Gallantry, and eight Air Medals, among others; and

13 WHEREAS, Colonel Plummer retired in 1975 and moved with his
14 wife, Kathy, and their three children to McAllen, where he built a
15 civilian career in real estate; he has remained proud of his
16 military service, and since 1988, he has played a leading role in
17 the design and planning of the Veterans War Memorial of Texas, which
18 will honor the 1.4 million individuals who have given their lives in
19 our nation's wars; and

20 WHEREAS, Americans owe a profound debt of gratitude to the
21 men and women who commit themselves to the defense of our freedom,
22 and Colonel Frank Plummer may take great pride in his more than 30
23 years of distinguished service to this nation; now, therefore, be
