RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, The Texas Association of Public Employee Retirement 2 Systems is holding its 26th Annual Conference in Austin March 29 3 through April 1, 2015, and the event provides a welcome opportunity 4 to honor this notable organization; and

5 WHEREAS, Founded in 1989, TEXPERS is a voluntary statewide 6 organization focused on the goals of protecting public employee 7 retirement systems in Texas as well as promoting quality management 8 by providing members with outstanding educational programs; and

9 WHEREAS, Since it was chartered, this nonprofit association 10 has provided forums for discussing state and national legislative 11 issues that affect Texas pension systems; it has also supplied 12 important information on retirement system administration, benefit 13 design, and federal programs relating to public pensions; and
