- 5 WHEREAS, Born on October 15, 1955, Mike Higgins embarked on
- 6 his career in public safety in 1978, when he became a firefighter
- 7 and paramedic for the Sherman Fire Department; he joined the staff
- 8 of the Texas State Association of Fire Fighters in 1988, and for
- 9 nearly three decades, he served as an advocate for firefighters
- 10 throughout the state; and
- 11 WHEREAS, In his work as the TSAFF's chief of staff, Mr.
- 12 Higgins tirelessly defended the health, safety, and well-being of
- 13 his fellow firefighters; he negotiated labor contracts,
- 14 represented firefighter rights in arbitration, and lobbied for
- 15 safer equipment and working conditions; despite his reputation for
- 16 being tough, he earned the respect and friendship of generations of
- 17 public officials; and
- WHEREAS, In 2005, his determined efforts helped lead to the
- 19 adoption of the Sean McKinnis Charitable Solicitation Act, which
- 20 allows firefighters to collect money on street corners throughout
- 21 the state in behalf of the Muscular Dystrophy Association;
- 22 moreover, Mr. Higgins assisted in the passage of similar laws in
- 23 California, Illinois, Florida, and other states; and
- 24 WHEREAS, A devoted family man, Mr. Higgins enjoyed the love

- 1 and support of his wife, Peggy, and their three children; and
- WHEREAS, Throughout a career in public safety that spanned 37
- 3 years, Mike Higgins upheld the highest standards of his profession,
- 4 and he leaves behind a record of achievement that his loved ones can
