- 1 WHEREAS, The city of Raymondville lost a respected civic
- 2 leader with the passing of former mayor Eustolio Gonzales on
- 3 November 9, 2014, at the age of 86; and
- WHEREAS, "Tolo" Gonzales graduated from Raymondville High
- 5 School and subsequently served as a member of the United States
- 6 Marine Corps during the Korean War; after receiving an honorable
- 7 discharge in 1954, he went on to earn a bachelor's degree in
- 8 education from The University of Texas--Pan American and a master's
- 9 degree from Texas A&M University--Kingsville; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Mr. Gonzales led an exemplary career in education
- 11 that spanned two decades with the Raymondville Independent School
- 12 District, and he also worked as a lecturer and consultant on migrant
- 13 education in Texas, Illinois, Indiana, and Wisconsin, where he
- 14 served as supervisor of Title I migrant education at the Wisconsin
- 15 Department of Public Instruction; and
- WHEREAS, Greatly admired for his dedication to his community,
- 17 Mr. Gonzales became Raymondville's first Hispanic mayor in 1973;
- 18 three years later, area voters chose him as a county commissioner, a
- 19 position in which he ably served for 12 years, and he earned the
- 20 distinction of being the first elected Hispanic county judge of
- 21 Willacy County in 1991; and
- 22 WHEREAS, Mr. Gonzales was also actively involved in the
- 23 Democratic Party, playing an instrumental role in campaigns for
- 24 numerous state and national candidates, including Senator Lloyd

- 1 Bentsen, Governor Ann Richards, Bob Krueger, and Garry Mauro; in
- 2 addition, he was appointed to the Texas Board of Aging by Governor
- 3 Mark White and was named chair of the Regional Review Committee by
- 4 Governor Richards; and
- 5 WHEREAS, This esteemed Texan further distinguished himself
- 6 as cofounder and a member of the board of directors of Amigos Del
- 7 Valle, and he was also a member of the Catholic Men's Club, the Our
- 8 Lady of Grace Parish Pastoral Council, the Mexican American Chamber
- 9 of Commerce, the Jaycees, the Texas State Teachers Association, the
- 10 Willacy County Industrial Foundation, the Texas College of Probate
- 11 Judges, and many other worthwhile organizations; receiving
- 12 well-deserved recognition for his outstanding efforts, he was
- 13 selected as a 2002 Notable Valley Hispanic honoree by The
- 14 University of Texas--Pan American library; and
- WHEREAS, A devoted family man, Mr. Gonzales enjoyed the love
- 16 and support of his wife, the former Emilia Margarita Saenz, his
- 17 college sweetheart with whom he shared more than a half-century of
- 18 marriage; over the years, the couple became the parents of six
- 19 children, Abigail, Kristine, Patricia, Steven, Edward, and
- 20 Gabriel, and they eventually knew the joy of welcoming into their
- 21 family two additional generations; and
- WHEREAS, Although it is impossible to gauge the full effect
- 23 of one man's life, some individuals leave their unmistakable mark
- 24 on the world as they move through it, and Tolo Gonzales's
- 25 contributions to his community will continue to resonate for many
- 26 years to come; now, therefore, be it
