R E S O L U T I O N

3 Davidson may find comfort in their treasured memories of this  
4 special young man, who passed away on February 2, 2015, at the age  
5 of 17; and

6           WHEREAS, Born in Austin on September 21, 1997, Mason Davidson  
7 was the son of David Wayne Cumberledge and Misty Michelle Davidson;  
8 he was a junior at Rouse High School in Leander, where he excelled  
9 academically, and he aspired to study mathematics at Texas Tech  
10 University; and

11           WHEREAS, This musically gifted young Texan played trumpet as  
12 a valued member of the Rouse Raider Marching Band; fond of singing  
13 as well, he liked to burst out in song to embarrass his girlfriend,  
14 Marlina, and made a point of serenading her every night; he had  
15 eclectic tastes and was a fan of Frank Sinatra, Elvis Presley, and  
16 Sean Kingston, as well as of Guns N' Roses and other rock bands; and

17           WHEREAS, An exceptionally warm, kind, and thoughtful person,  
18 Mr. Davidson endeared himself to innumerable people with his  
19 gentlemanly demeanor and upbeat personality; he had a wonderful

23 made a positive difference in the lives he touched, and he will
