

R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, The San Antonio Music Teachers Association is  
2 marking its 100th anniversary in 2015; and

3           WHEREAS, Founded on March 24, 1915, by a group of 19  
4 educators, the association has been affiliated since its inception  
5 with the Music Teachers National Association and the Texas Music  
6 Teachers Association; its membership had grown to about 150 by  
7 1919, when it published its first yearbook and directory; today,  
8 its members serve at all levels of the education system, and they  
9 perform for churches, synagogues, and the general public; and

10           WHEREAS, The organization has sponsored numerous activities  
11 for teachers and students, including lecture series, judged  
12 auditions, performances, and competitions; in 1988, group members  
13 raised money to establish the San Antonio Music Teachers  
14 Association Education Fund, which has awarded 36 scholarships to  
15 students over the years and has also provided study grants for  
16 teachers; and

17           WHEREAS, For the past century, members of the San Antonio  
18 Music Teachers Association have worked tirelessly to elevate  
19 standards of education and musicianship, and their endeavors have  
20 heightened appreciation for the ways in which the arts improve the  
21 quality of life in a community; now, therefore, be it

22           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 84th Texas  
23 Legislature hereby recognize March 31, 2015, as San Antonio Music  
24 Teachers Association Centennial Day and extend to the members
