2 celebrate their faith at Mount Zion Baptist Church in Crane; and

4 for many members of the Crane community since its establishment by
5 the Reverend T. J. Hollis in February 1945; this notable
6 institution has provided a setting for important rites of passage

8 have taken their wedding vows, baptized their children, and mourned
9 those loved ones who have come to the end of their journey; it is
10 there, too, that worshippers search for the essential truths and
11 wisdom that may help them to lead more ethical, harmonious, and

13 its members to reach out to those in need and to put into action the
14 tenets of their faith; and

16 numerous changes through the years to accommodate the evolving
17 needs of the congregation, it remains a constant and enduring
18 presence in Crane, and many who have worshipped there have
19 experienced a renewal of their faith and the welcoming embrace of a
