6 she and her husband, Jim Kilroy, shared 47 years together and became

7 the parents of two beloved sons, Mark and Keith; and

8 WHEREAS, In addition to her personal and professional

9 responsibilities, Mrs. Kilroy served as a volunteer with many

10 organizations in the Santa Fe and Hitchcock region; she played an

11 instrumental role in establishing the Santa Fe ISD School Education

12 Foundation and served on the board of Santa Fe Parks and Recreation;

13 a district leader for the Bay Area Council Cub Scouts, she helped

14 start the Cub Scout pack at Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic Church; as

15 a member of that church for more than 40 years, Mrs. Kilroy served

16 the congregation as a Eucharistic minister and as the organizer of

17 the church's auction, and she also fostered seven young children

18 through Catholic charities; furthermore, she volunteered as an EMT

19 and paramedic for the Santa Fe EMS ambulance and worked with Meals

20 on Wheels; and

21 WHEREAS, Of all her community endeavors, closest to her heart

22 was her establishment of the Mark Kilroy Foundation with her

23 husband; named in honor of the couple's 21-year-old son who was

24 kidnapped and killed in Mexico by drug smugglers in 1989, the

- 1 foundation was created to support anti-drug efforts; Mrs. Kilroy
- 2 also helped organize the Substance Abuse Free Environment program
- 3 and the annual Mark Kilroy Foundation Fundraiser, which helps
- 4 secure grants for youth counselors; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Deeply devoted to her family and her community,
- 6 Helen Kilroy lived a caring and purposeful life, and she will
- 7 forever be remembered with admiration and affection by all who held
- 8 her close to their hearts; now, therefore, be it
