RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, The Coastal Bend Alcohol and Drug Rehabilitation 2 Center in Corpus Christi, more commonly known as Charlie's Place 3 Recovery Center, is marking a significant milestone in 2015 with 4 the observance of its 50th anniversary; and

5 WHEREAS, Founded in 1965 by members of a local Alcoholics Anonymous group, the center started out as a small 24-hour halfway 6 7 house; previously, area residents with alcohol addictions would frequently end up in jail or the psychiatric ward due to a lack of 8 9 treatment facilities in the area; the halfway house provided a better alternative, and its efforts got a boost in 1967, when 10 11 Charlie Acklen became a resident; he soon became an essential 12 member of the organization in his role as the house manager, and the center became known as "Charlie's Place"; through the years, it has 13 14 grown to become one of the largest nonprofit residential treatment facilities in the state; and 15

WHEREAS, Today, Charlie's Place is housed in a renovated 16 former hotel and treats men and women age 18 and older suffering 17 from substance abuse or dependence; the center's dedicated and 18 caring staff assist clients by helping them understand their 19 20 addictions, teaching them how to rebuild their lives, and giving 21 them the skills needed to remain sober; services include 22 residential detoxification and intensive residential treatment, as 23 well as supportive care that benefits individuals as they move through the recovery process and search for housing and employment; 24
