## RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, A full and generous life drew to a close with the 2 passing of Robert Ray Lawson of Marshall on February 17, 2015, at 3 the age of 90; and

WHEREAS, Born in Ovilla on July 30, 1924, to William and Bunk Lawson, Robert Lawson grew up on a farm with his seven siblings during the Great Depression; he graduated from Midlothian High School in 1941 and was drafted into the U.S. Army during World War II, serving as a member of the Army Medical Corps in the Pacific theater; and

10 WHEREAS, Mr. Lawson returned to the United States and met the 11 love of his life, Mona, and they were joined in matrimony in 1947; 12 the couple enjoyed more than 60 years of marriage, and together they 13 became the proud and devoted parents of their son, David; and

14 WHEREAS, This esteemed Texan cofounded the Mar-Tex Glass 15 Company in 1952, and he played an instrumental role in the firm's 16 success over more than four decades of operation; and

WHEREAS, An active member of First United Methodist Church, 17 Mr. Lawson also shared his time and talents with numerous other 18 organizations in his community, including the Marshall Optimist 19 Club, the Marshall Rotary Club, and the Marshall Chamber of 20 Commerce; he was a chair of the Marshall Independent School 21 District School Board for many years and a board member of the 22 Region VII Education Service Center, Peoples State Bank, and the 23 Harrison Central Appraisal District; in recognition of 24 his
