R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The Denco Area 9-1-1 District in Lewisville has
2 received the 2015 Outstanding 9-1-1 Call Center/Program Award from
3 the NG9-1-1 Institute; and

4 WHEREAS, Headquartered in Washington, D.C., the institute is
5 a not-for-profit organization that works with the Congressional
6 NextGen 9-1-1 Caucus to promote the deployment of advanced,
7 effective Next Generation 9-1-1 emergency services across the
8 nation; it serves as a national clearinghouse and policy forum on
9 NG9-1-1 issues, and since its inception in 2003, its membership has
10 grown to include approximately 2,000 professionals, public safety
11 officials, policy makers, researchers, and concerned citizens; and

12 WHEREAS, The Denco Area 9-1-1 District implemented and
13 maintains the 9-1-1 system for Denton County and the entire city of
14 Carrollton, and it serves as the coordinating agency for 9-1-1
15 emergency service; created by special election in 1987, the
16 district sends emergency calls to public safety answering points at
17 the Denton County Sheriff's Office and in the police departments of
18 Carrollton, Denton, Flower Mound, Highland Village, Lake Dallas,
19 Lewisville, Roanoke, The Colony, the University of North Texas, and
20 Texas Woman's University; and

21 WHEREAS, Through its exceptional service to the public, the
22 Denco Area 9-1-1 District has saved countless lives and contributed
23 immeasurably to the well-being of area citizens, and its management
24 and staff may indeed take pride in this prestigious national
