1 WHEREAS, John Hatzel will be retiring as assistant chief of 2 the Universal City Fire Department in December 2016, drawing to a 3 close a notable career as a first responder that has spanned four and half decades; and 4 WHEREAS, Assistant Chief Hatzel joined the department as a 5 volunteer firefighter in 1970, and he became a full-time 6 7 professional firefighter two years later; in the decades since, he has been a leader and innovator for the department, becoming one of 8 the first members of the department to earn certification as an 9 emergency medical technician; he also initiated the Knox Box 10 program, which provides firefighters with keys to local businesses 11 12 in the event of an emergency after hours, and developed a fire prevention program for children that evolved into a stage 13 14 production with actors, clowns, and special effects; and 15 WHEREAS, This dedicated firefighter has received numerous certifications from the Texas Commission on Fire Protection, 16 including fire service instructor and advanced firefighter, arson 17 investigator, and inspector; he has also been certified as a master 18 police officer by the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement; and 19 WHEREAS, John Hatzel's dedication, professionalism, 20 21 commitment to protecting the safety and welfare of the public have greatly benefited the citizens of Universal City and earned him the 22 23 respect and admiration of his fellow firefighters, and he may
