11 they participate in three days of intense rehearsals and perform a
12 concert under the direction of a nationally recognized conductor;

15 Ms. Fulton is a junior at Lorena High School, where she has
16 distinguished herself as a gifted flutist and as president of the
17 theater troupe; she also enjoys playing with the Waco Symphony

19 Baylor Honor Flutes, and she is an active member of First
20 Presbyterian Church of Waco; and

22 Texan have placed her among the state's elite high school
23 musicians, and she may indeed reflect with pride on her outstanding
24 achievements; now, therefore, be it
