1 WHEREAS, Carlos Hisa was elected governor of the Ysleta del
2 Sur Pueblo in January 2015, and it is indeed appropriate to
3 recognize his outstanding contributions to the tribe at this time;
4 and

5 WHEREAS, A dedicated public servant, Mr. Hisa has been
6 involved in tribal governance for nearly two decades; he served
7 as lieutenant governor beginning in 2002, and he continued in
8 that role for an unprecedented tenure of 12 years; among other
9 executive responsibilities, he directed the administrative
10 systems, enterprises, and programs of the pueblo; and

11 WHEREAS, Mr. Hisa began his career as an administrative clerk
12 in the Contract Health Department; previously, he was a licensed
13 chemical dependency counselor for the Alcohol and Substance Abuse
14 Program, and in this role, he implemented innovative prevention and
15 intervention programs tailored largely to the needs of tribal
16 youth; and

17 WHEREAS, Committed to building the tribal nation while
18 honoring its traditions, Carlos Hisa has greatly benefited the
19 Ysleta del Sur Pueblo through his vision and leadership, and in so
20 doing, he has earned the respect and appreciation of many; now,
21 therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 84th Texas
23 Legislature hereby congratulate Carlos Hisa on his election as
24 governor of the Ysleta del Sur Pueblo and extend to him sincere best
