

R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, For the past century, the Texas A&M Engineering  
2 Experiment Station has served as the state's engineering and  
3 technology development agency; and

4           WHEREAS, The station was established in August 1914, and in  
5 1948, it was incorporated into The Texas A&M University System;  
6 today, TEES has a close relationship with Texas A&M University and  
7 partners with 15 other universities and 11 two-year colleges across  
8 the state; in carrying out its mission, it collaborates with  
9 communities, public school districts, the private sector, and the  
10 federal government; and

11           WHEREAS, Fostering innovation in research, education, and  
12 technology, TEES benefits industry and business in myriad ways; its  
13 outreach to community colleges helps to build the state's  
14 technology workforce and promotes the successful transfer of  
15 students from two-year to four-year institutions; in addition, TEES  
16 serves as a catalyst for collaborations that enhance research  
17 capabilities statewide and that put Texas in a strong position for  
18 securing federal grants; and

19           WHEREAS, Over the past 100 years, the Texas A&M Engineering  
20 Experiment Station has spurred economic development and provided  
21 practical answers to critical state and national needs, and in so  
22 doing, it has contributed significantly to the quality of life in  
23 the Lone Star State and beyond; now, therefore, be it
