Ervendberg, who had been asked to pastor the 8 church by Prince Carl of Solms-Braunfels before the first settlers 9 ever arrived on the banks of the Comal; the church incorporated in 10 11 October 1845, becoming the first congregation in the community; and 12 WHEREAS, The original church building was a cedar log structure; in 1875, the cornerstone was laid for the present-day 13 14 building, which over the years has been expanded and improved; the
