2 Investigator of the Year by the Corpus Christi Police Department in

6 conducting 28 operations and writing 21 search warrants, which
7 accounted for more than 25 percent of the division's production;

9 confiscation of illegal substances worth over \$2.6 million, and he

11 history of the department; and
