1           WHEREAS, Officer David Martinez of the Brookshire Police  
2 Department demonstrated great composure and courage on February 7,  
3 2015, when he thwarted a bank robbery in progress; and

4           WHEREAS, A two-year veteran of the police department, Officer  
5 Martinez was off duty working as a security guard at First Services  
6 Credit Union that afternoon when a man wearing a disguise and  
7 brandishing a handgun came into the lobby and forced everyone,  
8 including Officer Martinez, to lie down on the floor; and

9           WHEREAS, The suspect took the officer's weapon, forced a  
10 teller to give him cash, and fled the building; Officer Martinez  
11 retrieved his backup weapon and, at considerable risk to himself,  
12 followed the man; during a confrontation in the parking lot,  
13 Officer Martinez shot the suspect; and

14           WHEREAS, Officer Martinez's quick and decisive actions  
15 helped to avert what could have been an even greater tragedy, and he  
16 is truly deserving of special recognition for his bravery and  
17 dedication to protecting the public; now, therefore, be it

18           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 84th Texas  
19 Legislature hereby commend Officer David Martinez of the Brookshire  
20 Police Department for his heroism and extend to him sincere best  
21 wishes for continued success with his important work; and, be it
