6 sciences at the undergraduate level; Dr. Shelton has been honored
7 by her peers for her exceptional efforts to prepare students for
8 careers in mathematics; and

10 assistant professor at Southwestern University in 1987, and she was
11 made an associate professor in 1994; during her tenure, she has
12 guided many students as they have prepared their work to present at
13 mathematics conferences, encouraging them to go beyond the usual
14 requirements of undergraduate coursework; additionally, she has
15 served as chair of the mathematics and computer science department
16 and the natural sciences division, and she has made presentations
17 at a number of professional gatherings; and

18 WHEREAS, After developing an interest in mathematics in high
19 school, Dr. Shelton earned a bachelor's degree from Texas A&M
20 University and went on to attain a master's degree and a doctorate
21 from Clemson University; she enjoys spending leisure time with her
22 family and working in her garden, and she is an active member of the
23 Georgetown community; and

24 WHEREAS, Throughout her years of dedicated service,

1 Dr. Therese Shelton has exemplified the qualities that are the
2 hallmarks of a great professor, and she has earned the respect and
3 admiration of colleagues and students alike; now, therefore, be it
