

R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, The Levelland High School girls' basketball team  
2 enjoyed an exceptional 2014-2015 season, claiming the district  
3 title and advancing to the regional semifinals of the University  
4 Interscholastic League 4A playoffs; and

5           WHEREAS, Levelland High won each of its 10 games in league  
6 competition to clinch the District 2-4A crown; the team's thrilling  
7 run through the postseason began with a dominating 84-37 victory  
8 over Perryton High School, and the Loboettes went on to soundly  
9 defeat the squad from Andrews High to secure the area championship;

11           WHEREAS, In the regional quarterfinals, Levelland fell  
12 behind by 18 points in the second quarter to Greenwood High School  
13 before an impressive burst of offense in the second half propelled  
14 the Loboettes to a double-digit lead; these determined players then  
15 secured the game at the free throw line, netting 11 of 14 attempts  
16 in the fourth quarter to capture a 72-62 win; that triumph earned  
17 the Levelland players a trip to the regional semifinals, where they  
18 turned in a valiant effort but saw their season come to an end in a  
19 loss to Wylie High School; and

20           WHEREAS, Ably guided by head coach Clay Barnett and assistant  
21 coaches Trevor Tucek and Sarah Dormier, the Loboettes benefited  
22 from the vital contributions made throughout the season by each  
23 member of the team: Sujei Cera, Paige Royal, Gabie Ruiz, Courtney  
24 Villanueva, Lindsey Sharp, Paris McCoy, Peyton Himango, Maeci

1 Scott, Elizabeth Cera, Faith Garza, and Haylee Jackson; and

2 WHEREAS, The members of the Levelland Loboettes basketball  
3 squad have become a source of tremendous pride to their many  
4 supporters in the local community, and the teamwork and dedication  
5 they have demonstrated on the court will continue to serve them well  
6 in the years to come; now, therefore, be it
