1           WHEREAS, The D'Hanis High School girls' basketball team  
2 enjoyed an exceptional 2014-2015 season, advancing all the way to  
3 the semifinals of the University Interscholastic League 1A state  
4 playoffs; and

5           WHEREAS, After claiming the District 31 title with their  
6 stellar play against their league rivals, the Cowgirls started the  
7 postseason with a dominating victory over Burton High School in the  
8 area round and followed that performance with an exciting,  
9 last-second win against Goodrich High School in the regional  
10 quarterfinals; D'Hanis then topped Jonesboro High School in another  
11 hard-fought game by a score of 39-35 to keep its thrilling playoff  
12 run alive; and

13           WHEREAS, The Cowgirls proved up to the task once more in a  
14 48-46 triumph over Coolidge High School in the regional finals,  
15 storming back from a fourth quarter deficit to clinch the Region 4  
16 crown and secure the second state tournament berth in school  
17 history and the first since 1979; in its semifinal game, D'Hanis put  
18 up a determined effort, but ultimately lost to Nazareth High School  
19 to bring a memorable season to a close; and

21 assistant coach Todd Craft, the Cowgirls benefited from the vital  
22 contributions made throughout the year by each member of the team:

24 Lynch, Ashley Philipp, Mallory McCollum, and Shelby Gayre;

1 additional assistance was provided by managers Hallie Lynch and  
2 Jahnelin Costa; and

3 WHEREAS, The members of the Cowgirls basketball team have  
4 become a source of tremendous pride to their many supporters in the  
5 local community, and the hard work and dedication they have  
6 demonstrated will continue to serve them well in the years to come;  
7 now, therefore, be it
