1 WHEREAS, Jeanette Palmire retired as a patrol officer with
2 the Bellaire Police Department on March 7, 2015, concluding an
3 exemplary career that spanned 32 years; and

4 WHEREAS, When Officer Palmire joined the department in 1983,
5 it had only one other female member, and for much of her tenure, she
6 held her own in an otherwise all-male environment; she played a
7 major part in developing the department's Field Training Officer
8 program during the 1980s, and it became a model for other agencies;
9 and

10 WHEREAS, Officer Palmire demonstrated exceptional skill and
11 dedication as a patrol officer, and she turned down several
12 opportunities for promotion or special assignment in order to
13 remain in that role; always ready to help out wherever and whenever
14 needed, she brightened the days of her coworkers with her kind and
15 easygoing manner, and she was a caring mentor to many younger
16 officers; and

17 WHEREAS, Through her steadfast commitment to public safety,
18 Officer Palmire set a high standard to which others may aspire,
19 while earning the lasting respect and appreciation of her
20 colleagues and fellow citizens alike; now, therefore, be it

21 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 84th Texas
22 Legislature hereby congratulate Officer Jeanette Palmire on her
23 retirement from the Bellaire Police Department and extend to her
24 sincere best wishes as she embarks on the next exciting chapter of
