R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Officer Joseph L. Moon of the Corpus Christi Police
2 Department lost his life in the line of duty on June 10, 1938, and
3 his service and sacrifice will not soon be forgotten; and

4 WHEREAS, A motorcycle traffic officer who had served the
5 department for one year, Officer Moon was in pursuit of a speeding
6 motorist on Timon Boulevard in northeastern Corpus Christi on June
7 7, 1938, when he struck a curb and suffered severe abdominal
8 injuries; he underwent surgery but passed away a few days later; at
9 the time of his death, Officer Moon was survived by his wife and two
10 children; and

11 WHEREAS, Our state and nation benefit immeasurably from the
12 courage and commitment of law enforcement professionals such as
13 Officer Moon, who willingly place themselves in harm's way each day
14 to safeguard the lives and property of their fellow citizens; now,
15 therefore, be it

16 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 84th Texas
17 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life and exemplary service of
18 Officer Joseph L. Moon of the Corpus Christi Police Department.
