3 2014, at the age of 43; and

4 WHEREAS, Jeremy Brown was born on January 31, 1971, at the
5 Keesler Air Force Base Hospital in Biloxi, Mississippi, to Debra
6 and David Brown; he grew up in Mississippi and in his early years
7 lived in Salt Lake City, Las Vegas, and Odessa, before graduating
8 from high school in Bellaire, Texas, in 1989; and

9 WHEREAS, For more than 10 years, Mr. Brown worked as a
10 private investigator in Houston; in 1997, he received a bachelor's
11 degree in government from The University of Texas at Austin, and he
12 went on to earn his law degree at South Texas College of Law in
13 Houston; he was admitted to the bar in 2006 and opened his own
14 family law practice in Austin; and

15 WHEREAS, Mr. Brown spent as much time as he could pursuing an
16 active life out-of-doors, fishing along the Texas Coast and hunting
17 in South and West Texas; he was devoted to his three Labrador
18 retrievers, and he loved everything about Texas, from the history
19 and the landscape, to its music and its people; and

20 WHEREAS, Although his life ended far too soon, Jeremy Brown
21 will forever be remembered by his loved ones and his friends for his
22 kindness, his warmth, and his concern for others; now, therefore,
