2 February 12, 2015, at the age of 90, leaving behind a wealth of  
3 happy memories to be cherished by his wide circle of family and  
4 friends; and

5           WHEREAS, The son of Robert and Georgia Lee, Bob Lee was born  
6 on August 12, 1924, in Austin; he grew up in Wichita Falls and later  
7 attended school in Corpus Christi before graduating from Waco High  
8 School; answering his nation's call to duty, Mr. Lee served as a  
9 member of the U.S. Navy during World War II; he completed his  
10 military service and returned to the Lone Star State, earning his  
11 degree from The University of Texas at Austin in 1950; and

12           WHEREAS, Mr. Lee married the former Ann Edwards, and the  
13 couple shared 64 rewarding years together; he was the devoted  
14 father of five sons, James, Michael, Robert, Richard, and Donald,  
15 and he later knew the joy of welcoming four granddaughters and two  
16 great-grandchildren into his cherished family; and

17           WHEREAS, Devoted to his country, this esteemed Texan was a  
18 lifelong Republican, and he served as the cofounder of Republicans  
19 Against Marijuana Prohibition; in all his endeavors, Mr. Lee found  
20 great strength and inspiration in his Christian faith; and

21           WHEREAS, Kind and unpretentious, with a wonderful sense of  
22 humor and a gift for storytelling, Bob Lee will forever hold a  
23 special place in the hearts of all who had the good fortune to know
