- 1 WHEREAS, Proud area residents are joining together
- celebrate Austin County Day at the State Capitol on March 31, 2015,
- and this occasion provides a fitting opportunity to recognize the 3
- county's unique contribution to the story of the Lone Star State; 4

- 6 WHEREAS, American settlement in the county dates to the early
- 7 1820s, when the area became part of Stephen F. Austin's first
- colony; the first town to be established was San Felipe de Austin, 8
- which served as the administrative seat of the colony and as a 9
- social, cultural, and commercial center; and 10
- 11 WHEREAS, Austin County was created by the Constitution of
- 12 1836 and was formally organized by 1837; San Felipe was the county
- seat until 1848, when the county government was moved to Bellville; 13
- 14 and
- WHEREAS, Blessed with an abundance of water, grassland, and 15
- 16 forests, the county drew a steady stream of settlers, most of whom
- were engaged in agriculture; a number of towns grew substantially 17
- during the 19th century, including Bellville and Wallis and the 18
- railroad towns of Sealy and Kenney; and 19
- WHEREAS, During the 1800s, German and Czech immigrants began 20
- arriving in Austin County in appreciable numbers, and their 21
- influence is felt throughout the region in the societies that they 22
- 23 established and the many communities that they founded; the
- cultural mosaic of the county has been further enriched by 2.4

- 1 immigrants from Mexico, the largest foreign-born group to settle
- 2 there in the 20th century, and by African Americans, who played a
- 3 fundamental role in the county's development and in the creation of
- 4 numerous social and religious institutions; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Among the prominent Texans who have resided in
- 6 Austin County was Gail Borden Jr., a surveyor and newspaper
- 7 publisher who later invented a successful process for condensing
- 8 milk; another early citizen, Robert Justus Kleberg, fought in the
- 9 Battle of San Jacinto and held several prestigious public offices;
- 10 and
- 11 WHEREAS, Today, visitors and residents alike can explore the
- 12 county's rich heritage, preserved at the San Felipe de Austin State
- 13 Historic Site and in rural communities throughout the area, and
- 14 they enjoy hunting and fishing opportunities as well as a wealth of
- 15 special recreational events; and
- 16 WHEREAS, The citizens of Austin County have together built a
- 17 vibrant and distinctive corner of Texas, and they may indeed take
- 18 pride in their notable history as they look forward to a future
- 19 filled with promise; now, therefore, be it
- 20 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 84th Texas
- 21 Legislature hereby recognize March 31, 2015, as Austin County Day
