1 WHEREAS, St. Francis de Sales Catholic School in Houston is
2 commemorating the 50th anniversary of its founding with a
3 celebration on April 12, 2015; and

4 WHEREAS, The school held its first classes on September 8,
5 1964, for children in the first through the sixth grades; following
6 the Dominican education philosophy, St. Francis de Sales Catholic
7 School helps children to become grounded in their faith while
8 encouraging academic excellence and a vibrant sense of community;

10 WHEREAS, Over the years, St. Francis de Sales has expanded
11 its curriculum while remaining faithful to its established
12 principles, and today it serves approximately 470 students from
13 prekindergarten through eighth grade; in addition to traditional

15 Spanish, and technology; it is also home to a number of sports teams
16 and academic and service organizations, which give students myriad
17 opportunities for enhanced personal development and present
18 parents with occasions for further involvement in their children's

21 School has equipped a number of young Texans with a strong
22 educational foundation, and it is indeed fitting that the school be
