R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Beatrice Trevino has been elected commander of the
2 Charles Dixon American Legion Post No. 241 in Angleton; and

3 WHEREAS, The first woman to lead this post, Bea Trevino
4 served her country in the United States Army and Army National Guard
5 for 21 years and received numerous awards; her tours of duty
6 included assignments in Bosnia and Germany, and she was deployed
7 during Desert Storm; over the course of 11 years as a member of Post
8 No. 241, she has served as house committee chair, adjutant,
9 historian, and first vice commander; she represents the
10 organization in the Angleton Chamber of Commerce; and

11 WHEREAS, This dynamic Texan also belongs to the American
12 Legion Auxiliary, the Veterans of Foreign Wars, and the local
13 chapter of the Disabled American Veterans; within the American
14 Legion, Department of Texas, she has served as historian for the
15 Third Division and as a member of the Ninth District Color Guard;

17 WHEREAS, Since her retirement from the armed forces,
18 Ms. Trevino has worked with such nonprofit organizations as the
19 Brazoria County Alliance for Children and the Children's Advocacy
20 Center of Brazoria County; she is a graduate of the Angleton Police
21 Department's Citizen Police Academy, and she has participated in
22 the activities of its alumni association; and

23 WHEREAS, Bea Trevino has given generously of her time and
24 talents in behalf of her fellow veterans and the citizens of

1 Angleton, and she is indeed deserving of special recognition at
2 this time; now, therefore, be it
