RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, Residents of Jackson County are gathering in Austin
- 2 on April 21, 2015, to celebrate Jackson County Day at the State
- 3 Capitol, and this occasion provides a welcome opportunity to honor
- 4 the history and achievements of this notable area of the Lone Star
- 5 State; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Located along the Gulf of Mexico, this part of the
- 7 Coastal Prairie was once inhabited by the Karankawa people, and it
- 8 is thought that the early European explorers Cabeza de Vaca and La
- 9 Salle visited the area; in the 1820s, a number of the "Old 300"
- 10 families in Stephen F. Austin's first colony arrived, and the
- 11 communities they founded became known as the Alabama Settlement
- 12 because so many of the new arrivals had previously resided in that
- 13 state; and
- 14 WHEREAS, The area played a central role in the Texas
- 15 Revolution, serving as a training ground for Texan forces and
- 16 suffering destruction at the hands of the Mexican Army; after
- 17 independence was won in 1836, Jackson County was one of the original
- 18 23 counties formed in the newly established republic; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Cattle ranching and farming became the backbone of
- 20 the local economy in the mid-1800s, and these businesses remain
- 21 important to the county today, with rice, corn, and cotton being
- 22 prominent crops; moreover, oil and natural gas production have
- 23 employed many area residents since reserves were discovered in the
- 24 1930s; and

- 1 WHEREAS, The town of Edna was established in the 1880s as a
- 2 stop on a new railroad that was built through the coastal region; it
- 3 quickly eclipsed the existing county seat, Texana, and in 1883,
- 4 Edna became the center of government operations; other communities
- 5 in the county include Francitas, Ganado, LaSalle, La Ward, Lolita,
- 6 and Vanderbilt; and
- WHEREAS, Encompassing Lake Texana and Lavaca Bay, Jackson
- 8 County is a great place for boating, fishing, and hiking, and these
- 9 activities draw many people to sites such as the Brackenridge
- 10 Recreation Complex, which includes the Brackenridge and Texana
- 11 parks and campgrounds, as well as the Main Event Center; hunting and
- 12 bird-watching are also popular, and visitors can learn about local
- 13 history at the Texana Museum and Old Jail House in Edna; and
- WHEREAS, Celebrating their rich and colorful history as they
- 15 work together to build a bright future, the citizens of Jackson
- 16 County may take justifiable pride in the important role their
- 17 unique region continues to play in the story of the Lone Star State;
- 18 now, therefore, be it
- 19 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 84th Texas
- 20 Legislature hereby recognize April 21, 2015, as Jackson County Day
- 21 at the State Capitol and extend to the visiting delegation best
- 22 wishes for an informative and enjoyable stay in Austin.
