WHEREAS, Sean Carter of Winnsboro has faced extraordinary

2 challenges since being injured in an automobile accident in 2005, 3 and through his work as founder of WhenSeanSpeaks, Inc., he has transformed his personal tragedy into a campaign to save lives; and 4 5 WHEREAS, At the time the incident occurred, Sean Carter was a 22-year-old college student with plans to pursue a bachelor's 6 7 degree in business administration and go to law school; on the evening of March 26, 2005, he was headed home with friends after 8 visiting a few bars when the driver lost control of the vehicle and 9 crashed; and 10 11 WHEREAS, In addition to the multiple fractures and internal 12 injuries he suffered, Mr. Carter was diagnosed with a severe diffuse axonal injury, a type of brain trauma; after emerging from a 13 14 coma that lasted 39 days, he found he was unable to speak or walk, and his mother, Jenny Carter, had to assume guardianship of him; and 15 16 WHEREAS, Refusing to abandon hope under these circumstances, Mr. Carter began using a tablet computer with "type 17 to speech" software in an effort to reclaim his autonomy; he went on 18 to embrace a new sense of purpose as well when he began sharing his 19 story with others in 2007, as a participant in a Mothers Against 20 21 Drunk Driving Victim Impact Panel in Dallas; three years later, he founded the nonprofit organization WhenSeanSpeaks; and 22 23 WHEREAS, Since that time, Mr. Carter and his mother have 24 taken their message to tens of thousands of young people across the

- 1 nation; with funding from the Texas Department of Transportation,
- 2 they partnered with the Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service to
- 3 deliver presentations at 15 venues in 2013 and at 50 venues in 2014;
- 4 and
- 5 WHEREAS, WhenSeanSpeaks is dedicated to educating youth on
- 6 the devastating toll of drinking and driving, emphasizing that it
- 7 is equally important, as a passenger, to be mindful of the condition
- 8 of the driver of the vehicle; the organization is also dedicated to
- 9 improving the lives of people affected by traumatic brain injuries
- 10 through public awareness and research and to increasing the
- 11 availability of exercise facilities that are equipped to serve
- 12 persons with mobility needs; and
- WHEREAS, Throughout his ordeal, Mr. Carter has benefited
- 14 greatly from the support of his mother, his brothers, Todd and Ben,
- 15 and his father, Danny Carter, who passed away in 2012; Sean reached
- 16 a major milestone in 2013, when his recovery was deemed sufficient
- 17 to have his guardianship dismissed, and he continues to make
- 18 important strides toward complete independence; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Although Sean Carter's fight is not yet over, he has
- 20 made an inspiring contribution to the world through his example of
- 21 resilience and perseverance, his determination to assist others who
- 22 are enduring similar struggles, and his commitment to focus
- 23 attention on the dangers of drunk driving; now, therefore, be it
- 24 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 84th Texas
- 25 Legislature hereby commend Sean Carter for all that he has achieved
- 26 in his work with WhenSeanSpeaks, Inc., and extend to him sincere
- 27 best wishes for the future; and, be it further

- 1 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
- 2 prepared for Mr. Carter as an expression of high regard by the Texas
- 3 House of Representatives.
