1 WHEREAS, Family and friends are mourning the loss of DeWitt
2 Monroe Jones Jr. of Rio Grande City, who died on March 11, 2015, at
3 the age of 73; and

4 WHEREAS, Known affectionately as "Chachi," Mr. Jones was
5 born in Rio Grande City on September 22, 1941, to DeWitt Jones and
6 Trinidad Lopez; he was joined in marriage to Rafaela Ozuna, and the
7 couple were blessed with 12 children, DeWitt, Rose Marie, Alicia,
8 Robert, Mary Ann, Dave, Knox, Edward, Lillian, Carlos, Becky, and
9 DeWitt Chachi; and

10 WHEREAS, Mr. Jones owned two small businesses in the area,
11 Chachi's Wrecker Express and Chachi's Express Mart, but he was
12 perhaps best known for his work as a public servant; for 16 years,
13 from 1982 to 1998, he served as the Starr County justice of the
14 peace for Precinct 6; he further contributed to his community as
15 president of the Union Water Supply Corporation board of trustees
16 and as a member of the Colonia Resident Advisory Committee; in his
17 leisure time, he enjoyed fishing on the Rio Grande; and

18 WHEREAS, A devoted family man and a dedicated community
19 leader, Chachi Jones led a full and generous life, and he leaves
20 behind a record of service that his loved ones can remember with
21 pride; now, therefore, be it
