- WHEREAS, Child life specialists are on hand to help families,
- 3 including the siblings of patients, to manage feelings of anxiety
- 4 over the illness and hospitalization of a loved one; trained in the
- 5 areas of child development and psychology, they endeavor to ease
- 6 the concerns of younger family members in appropriate terms and to
- 7 make them as comfortable as possible during their visit; they also
- 8 offer compassionate assistance to children undergoing difficult
- 9 procedures, and they plan events, such as birthdays and holidays,
- 10 that can serve as a welcome respite for those facing long-term stays
- 11 at the center; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Social workers likewise play a significant role in
- 13 guiding families through this difficult experience; serving as a
- 14 liaison between parents and the health care system, they locate
- 15 appropriate resources, whether financial or other social services,
- 16 and make travel arrangements if a patient requires treatment at a
- 17 different facility; and
- WHEREAS, These distinguished professionals deserve high
- 19 praise for the work they perform, without which the delivery of care
- 20 at Dell Children's Medical Center would not be possible, and they
- 21 may take definite satisfaction in knowing that their efforts have
- 22 helped countless children on the path to healing and recovery; now,
