WHEREAS, The Kiwanis Club of Vernon, which was established in 1953, exemplifies this tradition of public spirit; under the able guidance of current president Billy Blount, the organization sponsors and participates in a wide variety of service projects, including the Veterans Day Breakfast, the Cool Down Vernon fan drive, Lions Club Baseball, Coats for Children, and Star Tree; in
