2 the Guthrie Common School District in February 2015, having
3 rendered outstanding service to area students over the course of
4 his distinguished tenure; and

5 WHEREAS, During his six years as superintendent of Guthrie
6 CSD, Dr. Coulter guided the district through a period of positive
7 growth while fostering a culture of learning and forward thinking;
8 he has overseen a number of significant developments, including a
9 greater emphasis on technology and a holistic approach to education
10 that extends beyond academics to encompass the overall health of
11 students; in addition, he instituted a new meal plan in the
12 district's cafeterias in order to provide for better food options
13 and to improve student outcomes in the classroom; and

14 WHEREAS, This esteemed administrator previously served as a
15 teacher and coach for the Jayton-Girard, Haskell, Rankin, Robert
16 Lee, Round Rock, and Pflugerville school districts; Dr. Coulter
17 also taught graduate studies at Wayland Baptist University, and he
18 continues to serve as a lecturer in the College of Education for The
19 University of Texas at Austin; and

20 WHEREAS, In retirement, Dr. Coulter looks forward to
21 spending more time with his wife on their ranch, where he hopes to
22 produce enough meat and produce to fulfill all of his family's
23 dietary needs; and

24 WHEREAS, The Guthrie Common School District has benefited

1 immeasurably from Dr. Coulter's visionary leadership and his
2 commitment to the well-being of students, and he may indeed reflect
3 with pride on a job well done; now, therefore, be it
