7 the school record for home victories, including 16 in a row to wrap

10 season earned the team a trip to Coral Gables, Florida, to compete

11 in the regional round of the NCAA Tournament; there, they defeated

12 Columbia University by a score of 3-2 and then bested the University

13 of Miami in a hard-fought three-game series to advance to the super

WHEREAS, Hosting the squad from the College of Charleston at

16 Rip Griffin Park in Lubbock, Tech benefited from a dominant Game 1

17 pitching performance from Chris Sadberry, who tossed a four-hit

18 shutout to lead Tech to a 1-0 victory; the team proved up to the task

19 once more in Game 2, as freshman Dylan Dusek threw five scoreless

20 innings and Adam Kirsch knocked in the game's only run to key a 1-0

21 triumph; the win clinched the school's first-ever berth in the

22 College World Series in Omaha, Nebraska, where they went on to

23 contend for college baseball's top prize; and
