R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Naomi Mangum of Waco has deservedly been honored  
2 with a 25-year service certificate by the National Society United  
3 States Daughters of 1812; and

4 WHEREAS, Founded in 1892, the N.S.U.S.D. of 1812 is a women's  
5 service organization dedicated to promoting patriotism, fostering  
6 a greater knowledge of American history, and preserving historical  
7 documents and relics; the group maintains, at its national  
8 headquarters in Washington, D.C., a museum and library devoted to  
9 the period extending from the close of the American Revolution to  
10 the end of the War of 1812; and

11 WHEREAS, The 25-year accolade is presented to individuals who  
12 have dedicated a quarter-century of service to the N.S.U.S.D. of  
13 1812; a charter member of the Jordan Bass Chapter, Ms. Mangum has  
14 volunteered countless hours to advancing the goals of the  
15 organization while serving in a number of important leadership  
16 roles, including chaplain, historian, and curator-librarian; and

17 WHEREAS, Naomi Mangum has helped to further the important  
18 mission of the National Society United States Daughters of 1812,  
19 and it is indeed appropriate to recognize her for her outstanding  
20 contributions; now, therefore, be it

21 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 84th Texas  
22 Legislature hereby congratulate Naomi Mangum on her receipt of a  
23 25-year service certificate from the National Society United States  
24 Daughters of 1812 and extend to her sincere best wishes for the
