- 13 in the 1950s, and construction of Lake Ray Hubbard in 1969 led to
- 14 growth in the recreational and tourism industry; and

- 16 who enjoy their community's rich heritage and family-friendly
- 17 environment; amid plentiful urban amenities, the city retains its
- 18 small-town charm, highlighted by its historic downtown business
- 19 district; residents and visitors alike are drawn to The Harbor, a
- 20 commercial, entertainment, and recreational area situated on the
- 21 picturesque shores of Lake Ray Hubbard, and the city has numerous
- 22 park facilities offering a variety of activities and special
- 23 events; and
