13 WHEREAS, Constable Robert Parker White of the El Paso County 14 Constable's Office, Precinct 1, earned the respect and admiration 15 of his peers for his commitment to serving the greater good, and his 16 contributions will not soon be forgotten; and

WHEREAS, Throughout his tenure, which spanned 16 years and 6 months, Constable White demonstrated the loyalty, courage, and self-sacrifice that are consistent with the highest ideals of the law enforcement profession; and
