R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, Citizens from across the Lone Star State are  
2 gathering at the State Capitol on May 4, 2015, for the Peace  
3 Officers' Memorial Ceremony, held in honor of those brave men and  
4 women who have lost their lives in the line of duty; and

5           WHEREAS, Texans everywhere are indebted to members of the law  
6 enforcement profession who, by their selfless devotion to the  
7 public welfare, have enabled us to enjoy the benefits of a peaceful  
8 and orderly society; and

9           WHEREAS, Too seldom recognized and sometimes taken for  
10 granted by the public they so faithfully serve, these intrepid  
11 individuals daily risk their lives in order to preserve domestic  
12 tranquility and to protect their fellow residents; and

13           WHEREAS, Border Patrol Agent Tyler R. Robledo of the U.S.  
14 Department of Homeland Security, Customs and Border Protection,  
15 earned the respect and admiration of his peers for his commitment to  
16 serving the greater good, and his contributions will not soon be  
17 forgotten; and

18           WHEREAS, Throughout his tenure, which spanned three years,  
19 Border Patrol Agent Robledo demonstrated the loyalty, courage, and  
20 self-sacrifice that are consistent with the highest ideals of the  
21 law enforcement profession; and

22           WHEREAS, Killed in the line of duty on Friday, September 12,  
23 2014, at the age of 34, Border Patrol Agent Robledo will long be  
24 missed by his family, his fellow peace officers, and the entire

2           WHEREAS, Though his life ended far too soon, Border Patrol  
3 Agent Robledo left behind a notable legacy that will forever be  
4 honored by those who follow in this difficult but essential  
5 profession; now, therefore, be it

6           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 84th Texas  
7 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of Border Patrol Agent  
8 Tyler R. Robledo of the U.S. Department of Homeland Security,  
9 Customs and Border Protection, and extend deepest sympathy to his  
10 relatives, friends, and fellow officers; and, be it further

11           RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be  
12 prepared for his family and that when the Texas House of  
13 Representatives adjourns this day, it do so in memory of Border  
14 Patrol Agent Tyler R. Robledo.
