- 21 moreover, the Green Report, which she produces each year for KHCB,
- 22 informs area residents about environmental programs, events, and
- 23 best practices and fosters environmental stewardship; and
- 24 WHEREAS, This dynamic Texan has contributed to virtually

- 1 every environmental endeavor in her community and to a number of
- 2 area-wide efforts as well; she helped found the Northeast
- 3 Environmental Team, and she serves as president of the
- 4 organization, which coordinates such initiatives as Enviro-Camp,
- 5 Enviro-Fair, and the Recycles Day Flea Market; Ms. Burns is also a
- 6 founder of the Trinity River Environmental Education Society, and
- 7 she has established numerous programs to foster awareness of
- 8 environmental issues; she has given generously of her own time and
- 9 resources to promote sustainability, and she has spoken extensively
- 10 on the issue to schools, garden clubs, children's camps, and other
- 11 groups around the state; and
- WHEREAS, Widely admired for her professional accomplishments
- 13 and volunteerism, Ms. Burns has been named a Hometown Hero by the
- 14 Northeast Tarrant Chamber of Commerce; and
- WHEREAS, Fran Burns has dedicated herself to making Haltom
- 16 City an even better place in which to live and work, and her
- 17 achievements will continue to benefit residents for years to come;
