1 WHEREAS, The Nueces County Coalition for Crime Victims'
2 Rights is hosting the 18th annual Corpus Christi observance of
3 National Crime Victims' Rights Week from April 19 through 25, 2015;

5 WHEREAS, Sponsored by the United States Department of Justice
6 Office for Victims of Crime, this important national event was
7 established to empower victims by making them aware of community
8 support and by fostering an atmosphere in which they feel safer and
9 more capable of reaching out for assistance; the weeklong
10 activities encourage citizens to listen to crime victims who come
11 forward and to aid in their journey to healing; and

13 Communities, Empowering Victims," and the Nueces County Coalition
