3 exemplary 40-year tenure with that agency; and

5 Mr. Ramirez earned his bachelor's degree from Angelo State
6 University in 1972; he served as a teacher and coach in the Eden
7 Independent School District and began his career in law enforcement
8 as a reserve deputy for the Tom Green County Sheriff's Department;

10 WHEREAS, Mr. Ramirez joined DPS in 1975, and he held a number
11 of important positions over the next four decades, eventually
12 achieving the rank of senior corporal; he has held assignments in
13 San Angelo and El Paso, and for the last several years, he has been a

15 WHEREAS, Corporal Ramirez received his master peace
16 officer's certification from the Texas Commission on Law
17 Enforcement Officer Standards and Education, and he was named the
18 winner of the 1996 Hale Achievement Award for his work in safety
19 advocacy; moreover, he is a member of the Texas State Troopers
20 Association and the Department of Public Safety Officers
21 Association; and

22 WHEREAS, In all his endeavors, Mr. Ramirez enjoys the love
23 and support of his wife, Sylvia, his daughters, Michelle and
24 Melanie, and his three grandchildren, Alisa, Matthew, and Morgen;
