    WHEREAS, Freddy James Anderson of San Antonio is being inducted into the Prairie View Interscholastic League Coaches Association Hall of Fame on July 18, 2015; and

    WHEREAS, Born and raised in Kountze, Mr. Anderson attended George Washington Carver High School; after earning a spot on the school's basketball team, he quickly proved himself an athlete of notable ability, and he helped lead the squad to a number of titles during his time as a Carver student; and
