1 WHEREAS, Mark Moeller is retiring as chief of the Rockwall
2 Police Department on July 17, 2015, drawing to a close a notable
3 career in law enforcement that has spanned nearly four decades; and

4 WHEREAS, Chief Moeller joined the Dallas Police Department in
5 July 1977, and over the next 24 years, he distinguished himself in a
6 variety of assignments until retiring from the department as the
7 lieutenant in command of the robbery unit; he also earned
8 bachelor's and master's degrees, and he is a graduate of the FBI
9 National Academy; and

10 WHEREAS, In April 2002, this outstanding peace officer was
11 appointed as chief of the Rockwall PD, and during his exemplary
12 13-year tenure, he has helped guide the city through a period of
13 rapid growth; as Rockwall's population has nearly doubled, Chief
14 Moeller has overseen the growth of the department from 45 officers
15 and 18 civilian staffers to 79 officers and 22 civilian employees;

17 WHEREAS, Chief Moeller's dedication, professionalism, and
18 commitment to excellence have greatly benefited the citizens of
19 Rockwall and earned him the respect and admiration of his fellow
20 officers, and he may indeed reflect with pride on a career well
21 spent as he embarks on the next exciting chapter of his life; now,
