R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, For more than eight decades, the Frisco Garden Club
2 has worked diligently to beautify public spaces and improve quality
3 of life in North Texas; and

4 WHEREAS, One of the oldest institutions of its kind in
5 Frisco, the club was founded in 1932 by a group of women who wished
6 to foster interest in home gardening, encourage civic engagement,
7 and work toward the protection and conservation of native plants,
8 wildflowers, and bird species; and

9 WHEREAS, Today, the Frisco Garden Club has grown to include
10 84 active and 4 honorary members who remain committed to the club's
11 motto of "A flower in every garden, joy in every heart"; the
12 organization gives back to the wider community by conducting
13 plantings at parks, organizing the annual Frisco Veterans of
14 Foreign Wars Memorial Day Service, and completing a number of other
15 worthwhile projects; moreover, the club works together with the
16 Frisco Educational Foundation to award scholarships to local
17 students seeking a college degree in horticulture, agricultural
18 sciences, or environmental sciences; and

19 WHEREAS, The Frisco Garden Club has brightened and enriched
20 the lives of fellow citizens through its careful stewardship of the
21 natural world, and its many achievements are indeed deserving of
22 special recognition; now, therefore, be it
