## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Ysleta Independent School District in El Paso is
 celebrating the 100th anniversary of its founding in 2015; and

3 WHEREAS, The origins of the district can be traced back to 4 1915, when voters approved a \$17,000 bond measure to build a school 5 on the corner of Alameda Avenue and Harris Street; two years later, 6 Ysleta Elementary School opened its doors to elementary and 7 secondary students from the village of Ysleta; and

8 WHEREAS, In 1923, the San Jose, Texico, and Ysleta school 9 districts combined to form the Ysleta Common School District, and a 10 \$30,000 bond measure was passed to fund the construction of a second 11 school; the district was renamed the Ysleta Independent School 12 District in 1937, and at the time it served a student population of 13 2,000 at five campuses, including Ysleta High School; and

14 WHEREAS, Today the third-largest school district in the city of El Paso, Ysleta ISD encompasses 7 high schools, 11 middle 15 schools, 37 elementary schools, 3 prekindergarten centers, and 6 16 17 special campuses, which together provide a supportive and innovative learning environment to more than 42,500 students; along 18 with its growth in enrollment, the district has seen considerable 19 progress in student achievement, and 10 of its campuses have been 20 designated as National Blue Ribbon Schools by the U.S. Department 21 of Education; and 22

WHEREAS, Although the community has experienced a panorama of
 change over the past century, Ysleta ISD has remained steadfast in
