1           WHEREAS, Lieutenant Irvin M. Brown of the Nueces County  
2 Sheriff's Office lost his life in the line of duty on February 13,  
3 1995, and his service and sacrifice will not soon be forgotten; and

4           WHEREAS, In charge of the DARE program since 1987, Lieutenant  
5 Brown suffered a fatal heart attack while driving the agency's DARE  
6 vehicle on the John F. Kennedy Memorial Causeway; the lieutenant  
7 was survived by his wife; and

8           WHEREAS, Our state and nation benefit immeasurably from the  
9 courage and commitment of law enforcement professionals such as  
10 Lieutenant Irvin M. Brown, who willingly place themselves in harm's  
11 way each day to safeguard the lives and property of their fellow  
12 citizens; now, therefore, be it

14 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life and exemplary service of  
15 Lieutenant Irvin M. Brown of the Nueces County Sheriff's Office.
