1 WHEREAS, The Honorable Veronica Escobar has ably served the
2 people of El Paso County as county judge for four years, and her
3 knowledge and dedication have earned her the respect of many people
4 along the way; and

5 WHEREAS, Since taking office in 2011, Judge Escobar has
6 promoted expanded access to health care through her support for the
7 El Paso County Hospital District and El Paso Children's Hospital;
8 she has also worked diligently to make government more effective,
9 efficient, and transparent; long focused on border issues, she has
10 provided an El Paso perspective on immigration in three op-ed
11 columns published by the *New York Times*; and

20 Award from the Texas Association of Mexican American Chambers of
21 Commerce, the Women of Integrity Award from Women for an Ethical El
22 Paso, and the Human Rights Safe Communities Award from the Border
23 Network for Human Rights; and

1 contributions to the betterment of life in El Paso County over the
2 course of her tenure as a public servant, and she may take
3 justifiable pride in her exemplary record of achievement; now,
