1 WHEREAS, Linda Fitzner, a theater arts teacher at Gold-Burg
2 High School, has been nominated for a 2015 Outstanding Teacher of
3 the Humanities Award; and

4 WHEREAS, Each year, Humanities Texas recognizes exemplary
5 educators across the state who teach such subjects as English,
6 foreign languages, history, language arts, social studies, art,
7 drama, and music; the 12 individuals who will be selected as the
8 2015 Outstanding Teacher honorees will receive a \$5,000 cash award,
9 and their schools will receive an additional \$500 for the purchase
10 of humanities-based instructional materials; and

11 WHEREAS, Linda Fitzner has been a member of the Gold-Burg
12 High School faculty for 10 years; she directs the school's popular
13 annual musical variety show, known as Celebration, which introduces
14 young people to many areas of the performing arts, and she also
15 oversees the Gold-Burg One-Act Play teams, two of which have
16 advanced to state UIL competition; this accomplished educator has
17 more than a quarter-century of experience and previously taught at
18 Bowie High School and at Centennial High School in Frisco; and

19 WHEREAS, The dramatic arts broaden horizons and deepen
20 understanding of the human condition, and through her skill,
21 enthusiasm, and dedication to her field, Linda Fitzner has enriched
22 the lives of numerous students; now, therefore, be it

24 Legislature hereby congratulate Linda Fitzner on being nominated
