1 WHEREAS, The girls' basketball team of Cypress Woods High
2 School reached the pinnacle of success by winning the University
3 Interscholastic League 6A state championship on March 7, 2015; and

4 WHEREAS, The title game victory closed out an unforgettable
5 year in which Cypress Woods went undefeated to claim the district
6 crown and then blazed a path through the playoffs; winning its
7 postseason contests by an astounding average of 27 points per game,
8 the team advanced to the state tournament at the Alamodome in San
9 Antonio, where they beat Wagner High School by a score of 79-60 in
10 the semifinals to earn a place in the 6A championship game; and

11 WHEREAS, Matched up against the team from Dallas Skyline High
12 School in the tournament final, the Lady Wildcats maintained the
13 lead throughout the first quarter, but ended the half trailing by
14 four points; demonstrating their undeniable will to win, the team
15 surged to the lead again in the second half and went on to record a
16 57-49 triumph; senior Erica Ogwumike scored 26 points and grabbed 8
17 rebounds in a performance that earned her the Most Valuable Player
18 award; and

19 WHEREAS, Excelling through teamwork, the Lady Wildcats also
20 benefited from the outstanding contributions made throughout the
21 year by the other members of the roster: Shelby Stephenson, Tatyana
22 Perez, Hannah Dolinsky, Olivia Holmes, Jasmine Williams, Madelin
23 Cowden, Madison Goodson, Kayla Alker, Nancy Mulkey, and Cate Reese;
24 these talented student-athletes were guided by head coach Virginia

1 Flores, who inspired the team to perform to its full potential; and

2 WHEREAS, Exhibiting a combination of exceptional talent and
3 fierce determination, the Lady Wildcats have proved themselves one
4 of the finest high school teams in Texas, and their success is a
5 source of great pride to their many supporters in the local
6 community; now, therefore, be it
